Dear Parishioners,

Our Thanksgiving Day Mass was very well attended and I was edified by the amount of canned goods and other food items that were brought to Mass. Pope Francis has been reminding us of our responsibility to show compassion for the poor and you provided a wonderful example for all of us to follow. Thank you also to all of you who volunteer your time or donate money in support of our food pantry ministry.

We have a new Advent wreath this year thanks to John Toups and Ford Thomas. In previous years we have used the old baptismal font as a pedestal on which to place a garland wreath. This year, our parishioner and liturgical environment coordinator John Toups designed a wooden stand to support the Advent candles and wreath, and then commissioned Baton Rouge furniture maker Ford Thomas to build it. It is a wonderful addition to our church and liturgy.

We can transform our lives and our community this Advent by each making a commitment to go to confession before Christmas. We already have a loving parish family but think of how much better we would be if everyone regularly sought the forgiveness of Christ in the sacrament of confession. Our Advent Penance service is scheduled for Tuesday, December 20, at 6:30 p.m. We also have our regular Saturday afternoon confessions from 3:30 – 4:15 p.m. every week.

Thursday, December 8, is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception and a holy day of obligation. We will celebrate a Vigil Mass on Wednesday, December 7, at 6:00 p.m., and then a Mass on Thursday morning at 8:00 a.m. We honor the Blessed Virgin Mary as patroness of the United States of America under the title of the Immaculate Conception. (Holy Family Parish in Port Allen will have a 6:00 p.m. Mass on Thursday evening if that time is more convenient.)

The annual appeal for the Retirement Fund for Religious is next weekend, December 10 & 11. This is our chance to help provide for our consecrated religious who have given so much to the Church over the years. Since this is also the weekend for our monthly Building Fund collection, I ask that you place your contributions in envelopes marked "Religious Retirement" and then drop them in the first collection.

We also have a Parish Blood Drive taking place next Sunday, December 11. The Advent season is a nice time to give of ourselves in preparation for receiving God's gifts at Christmas, so please donate if you are able.

Finally, please mark your calendars for our *Advent/ Christmas Concert* to be held on Tuesday, December 13, at 7:00 p.m. in the church. Admission is free but you are invited to bring a canned good for our food bank. A Christmas Cookie reception will follow in the Parish Activity Center.
