The Mass Intention Book is open for the scheduling of Masses for 2024/2025. If you wish to schedule a Mass, please fill out the Mass Intention form below **including the yellow highlighted area**. After filling in the form, print it and bring it with cash or your check made payable to St. John the Baptist Catholic Church to the Parish Office on any day the office is open. Please list the available date and time preferred after consulting the office calendar for available options. The stipend is \$5.00 per Mass. Please follow our guidelines below:

- Parishioners may request up to 12 Mass intentions per year at \$5.00 each.
- There can only be one intention per Mass for 7:30 AM Sunday, all weekdays, holy days, and first Saturday Masses. This will be referenced as single intention Masses.
- More than one person may request intentions for 4:30 PM Saturday, 9:00 AM Sunday, and 11:00 AM Sunday Masses. This will be referred to as multiple intentions Masses.
- One Mass will be said for the Parishioners of St. John the Baptist each weekend. On the date/time this Mass is said, no other intentions will be accepted for that Mass. The time of “For the Parishioners” Masses will rotate monthly.
- Intentions will be announced during the Mass they are scheduled for.
- To schedule a Mass Intention, come to the Church Office any day the office is open and consult the office calendar for available dates/times.
