In his book "The Catholic Imagination" published in 2000, the priest novelist and sociologist Father Andrew Greeley wrote: "Catholics live in an enchanted world, a world of statues and holy water, stained glass and votive candles, saints and religious medals, rosary beads and holy pictures." I very much like his description of our Catholic sensibility. We do live in an *enchanted world* surrounded by numerous reminders of God's presence which provide various opportunities for entering into communion with our God.

This Feast of All Saints is much loved by the Catholics of Louisiana. We each have our favorite saints that we look to for strength and inspiration in times of need. We also take pride in caring for our cemeteries which hold the remains of so many local "saints" who are still remembered with fondness by family and friends. Our plans for doing some landscaping in our parish cemetery have been delayed but not abandoned. We will try to get things started in the spring.

November 1-7 is National Vocation Awareness Week for Catholics in the United States. Pope Francis wrote that "Responding to God's call means allowing Him to help us leave ourselves and our false security behind, and to strike out on the path which leads to Jesus Christ, the origin and destiny of our life and our happiness." Please offer special prayers this week that our parish may produce vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life.

This Friday evening and Saturday morning, November 6-7, is the monthly all-night Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament led by our Catholic Daughters and Knights of Columbus. The twelve hour period begins at 8:00 p.m. Friday evening and ends with 8:00 a.m. Mass on Saturday morning. A schedule is available in the back of church if you would like to sign-up for an hour of prayer and adoration in the presence of our Lord.

In honor of the upcoming Veterans Day we are planning to honor all of our veterans at our 4:30 p.m. Vigil Mass next Saturday, November 7, 2015. The ongoing conflicts in the Middle East have served as a necessary reminder of the debt we owe to our service men and women who work to build peace and protect our country from terrorism. All veterans and their families

are invited to attend the Mass so that we can offer our prayers and gratitude.
