Dear Parishioners.

This Sunday, September 15, is designated as *Catechetical Sunday* for Catholic parishes and schools in the United States. It coincides with the start of Christian Formation classes in Parish Schools of Religion, as well as with RCIA sessions for those inquiring into the Catholic faith, and bible studies for adult Catholics interested in deepening their faith. We are blessed to have all of these opportunities available here at St. John the Baptist thanks to our many dedicated and talented catechists. Formation classes for our children start on Monday night so please say a prayer for all of our students and teachers.

We have so many different groups involved in faith formation that it is sometimes difficult to find a room to meet. It is sort of a good problem to have since it points to the vitality of our parish community. In recognition of the importance of Christian Formation, we recently painted all of the classrooms in our religious education building to provide a brighter learning environment for our children. The project began this summer through the efforts of Patrick Landaiche, our seminarian, and was completed thanks to the hard work of Wallace Thibodeaux, Richard Rabalais, and Larry Durbin.

In addition to the newly painted classrooms, we also have some new benches for our covered walkway which were designed and built by Gaven Devillier as an Eagle Scout project. They provide a nice place to sit and visit while waiting for friends or a ride home, and were even painted to match our building. They are also quite popular with the customers who visit the Zippers' Thrift Shop on Thursday mornings. Great job Gaven and congratulations on earning the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout!

Unfortunately I will have to miss the opening of our Christian Formation classes due to the Louisiana State Priests Convention taking place in New Orleans this week. This convention began about 20 years ago and is held every five years, always in New Orleans, and provides an opportunity for priests to continue our formation and grow in fraternity with one another. We also invite priests from Mississippi, Alabama, and east Texas to join us for a week of keynote addresses, breakout sessions, prayer liturgies, and socials.

The large group addresses will be given by Archbishop Wilton Gregory of Atlanta, Cardinal Sean O'Malley of Boston, and Archbishop Gregory Aymond of New Orleans. The breakout session topics and presenters include "Preaching" by Father Peter Cameron, O.P., editor of Magnificat; "Evangelization Using Technology & Social Media" by Rocco Palmo, journalist of "Whispers in the Loggia;" "Parish Administration: Spiritual & Pastoral Leadership" by Father Bill Dickinson, director of Catholic Leadership Institute; "Clergy-to-Clergy Relationships across Generational Lines" by Msgr. Michael Jamail, Beaumont; and "Bioethics and End-of-Life Issues" by Father Tad Pacholczyk, director of education, National Catholic Bioethics.

Since all of the priests will be at the convention this week, we will have Communion Services in place of our 8:00 a.m. weekday Masses September 17-20. Sorry I have to miss the Parish Pot-Luck dinner this Thursday but enjoy the meal without me!
